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### **Digital Planning Essentials for Your Job**

This workshop aims to get personal with digital technology and planning. Taking a technology-agnostic approach, this session will help participants identify how newly available digital technology can be applied in their own jobs, including consideration of artificial intelligence, internet of things, mixed reality (augmented and virtual), smart cities and data infrastructures. After a brief, plain-language introduction – participants will form small groups based on scale of professional interest - site, street, suburb and city.

Working together with several facilitators, and drawing on the examples from earlier conference sessions, participants will map out their day to day planning tasks and identify where these methods and technologies can be integrated into their work. The outputs from each group will be collated and shared to inform the development of PIAs response to this rapidly changing area. It is highly recommended, although not essential, that participants also attend Claire’s earlier presentation in “Session: 3A Conversations - Digital Disruption – what does this mean for planners?” in order to get the most out of the workshop.
